





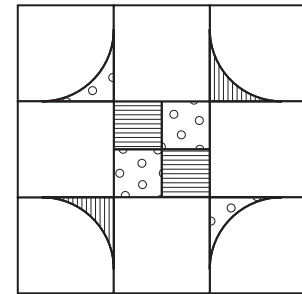
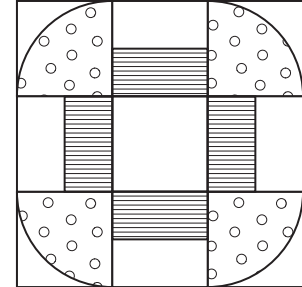
# Spinning Wheels

Spinning Wheels is a dimensional curved piecing pattern. Make these simple curvy blocks using your scraps or pre-cuts. The pattern features 5 Spinning Wheel Blocks and 4 Alternating Four-patch blocks. If you are using scraps, keep the background and border fabrics the same or very close in value. To facilitate color placement, cut multiples of bright and dark fabrics.

Use 1/4" seam allowance throughout. Wall-hanging: 38½" x 38½".

	Medium (border background)	1 - 1½" strip 2 - 2½" strips 1 - 4½" strips 2 - 6½" strips	1 - 1½" x 21" strip, Strip-Set 2 20 - 2½" squares, 20 f 4 - 4½" squares 12 - 4½" x 6½" strips 8 - 2½" x 6½" strips
