

Nova's Featherweight 221 Maintenance Workshop Supply List

This is a maintenance workshop for functioning sewing machines, not a repair workshop for machines that are **not functioning well**. If your machine is not sewing well, you will need to schedule a time with me prior to the class for me to repair it.
