

- Lightweight Fusible Webbing (for machine applique)
- Lightweight Fusible Interfacing
 - Stabilizer
 - Heat Resistant Template

Thank you for joining this class—we are going to have fun!!
The following fabric and supply information is what you will need to prepare and finish the top of your quilt, you will need to purchase backing separately.

Fabric Information—Designer Size

I used a line filled with bright reds, blues and greens and accented with yellow and grey. You can use a softer variety as well with pastels or even scraps. I will be sharing pillows, table runners and toppers options too.

The important thing is to choose 3-4 main colors and add 2-3 secondary colors to give each block a colorful and exciting look.

There are (13) blocks total with side triangles, sashing, etc.

Dresden Blades (variety)

Background (light, White)

Setting Background (Med/light Green)

Sashing strips (Light Med Pale Orange)

Border 1 and Binding (Colorful, Bold Print)

1 yard

2/3 yard

1 yard

Border 2 (Light Print) 1 yard

Optional: Filler Flannel (white) 1/3 yard (helpful for center circles)

Backing and Batting 4-1/4 yards

Finished Size 59 x 59

The following information is for *Queensize* version of original quilt.
The fabric quantities will change, but supplies/notions will be the same.

Fabric Information—Queensize

There are (18) blocks total with side triangles, sashing, etc.

Dresden Blades (variety);

6 Charm Packs <u>or</u> (2) fat quarters of 12 choices—use 6 color groups The important thing is to choose 3-4 main colors and add 2-3 secondary colors to give each block a colorful and exciting look.

Background (light, *White*) 1-1/2 yard

Setting Background (Med/light *Green*) 1-1/2 yard

Sashing strips (Light Med *Pale Orange*) 1 yard

Border 1 and Binding (Colorful, Bold Print) 1-1/2 yards

Border 2 (Light Print) 1-1/2 yard

Optional: Filler Flannel (white) 1/2 yard

Backing and Batting 6 yards

Finished Size 89 x 108
