Simple Lady designs focuses on quilts, toppers, runners, gifts, etc that can be done in no time! In my lecture I show the importance of creating and the benefits for all. I bring merchandise to sell that coincides with the SimpleLady™ theme as well as other patterns and kits. The fee for this lecture is \$350.00.

I try to keep both my lectures light hearted with plenty of free discussion. I enjoy interacting with the group and love the feed back they often share. I am able to pull the group together as needed to ensure the discussion does not get off track or out of control.

Workshops
