August 31, 2016

A Special Council Meeting of the Governing Body for the City of Ogden was scheduled for Wednesday, August 31, 2016 at 7:00 p.m. for the object and purposes of:

1. Pat Collins, Riley County Fire Department: Discussion of future location of Fire Station.
2. Executive Session: Land Acquisition Matters.
3. City Acquisition of land for future Fire Station.
4. Bernard Irvine; Tax Sale Discussion.

The meeting was called to order at 7:02 p.m.

The following members were present: Roger Graham, Ken Carroll, Ed Burch, Eladio Reid and Mayor Pence. Attorney Irvine was present. Jim Arp was not present.

Pat Collins, Riley County Fire Department: Discussion of future location of Fire Station.

Collins passed out a memorandum on what the Fire Department's needs are and the locations that have been considered.

Collins commented that the locations that have been considered have mostly ended up being in the flood plain in which funding can't be secured to build the new station. He also commented that other locations on the memo may be considered to be cost prohibitive and not feasible for a number of other reasons.

Collins and the Council as well as citizens in attendance discussed different locations and options on Collin's memo.

Carroll moved to recess into Executive Session to discuss Land Acquisition Matters until 7:55 p.m. with Pat Collins being included Seconded by Burch. Motion carried.

Burch moved to return to Regular Session. Seconded by Reid. Motion carried.

City acquisition of land for future Fire Station.

Carroll moved to table the city acquisition of land for future Fire Station until the County and City can get further information. Seconded by Burch. Motion carried.

Bernard Irvine; Tax Sale Discussion.


