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The Regular Meeting of the Governing Body for the City of Ogden was scheduled on Wednesday, August 03, 2016 at 7:00 p.m.

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m.

The following members were present: Roger Graham, Ken Carroll, Jim Arp, Ed Burch, Eladio Reid and Mayor Pence. Attorney Irvine was not present.

Mayor Pence invited the public to present comments to the governing Body.

Approval of Agenda:

Mayor Pence commented that Agenda items numbers 8,9,12 and 13 needed to be removed.

Burch moved to approve the Agenda with the removal of Agenda items 8,9,12 and 13. Seconded by Reid. Motion carried

Approval of Minutes:

Burch moved to approve the minutes from the 7/20/16 Council Meeting. Seconded by Arp. Motion carried.

PUBLIC HEARING: Russel Shipley- Sink Gordon & Associates: Presentation of the 2017 Budget.

Russell Shipley-Sink Gordon & Associates presented the 2017 Budget. The total mill levy is 40.943 and is comprised of the following: General Fund 22.998, Bond and Interest Fund 4.319 and Employee Benefit Fund 13.626. Shipley commented that the Budget has been published and that a copy has been available at the City Hall for anyone to review. He stated that in presenting the budget, there were no changes other than what were discussed at the Work Session.

Mayor Pence opened the Public Hearing for comments from the public. The Governing Body listened to comments from the public.

Mayor Pence closed the Public Hearing.

Adopt Resolution 08-03-16A. A Resolution expressing the property taxation policy of Ogden, Kansas with respect to financing the Budget for 2017.

Carroll moved to Adopt Resolution 08-03-16A. A Resolution expressing the property taxation policy of the city of Ogden, Kansas, with respect to financing the annual budget for 2017. Seconded Reid. Graham, Carroll, Burch and Reid voted in favor. Arp opposed. Motion carried.

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Adopt 2017 Budget.

Burch moved to adopt 2017 Budget. Seconded by Reid. Graham, Carroll, Burch and Reid voted in favor. Arp opposed. Motion carried.

Kathy Sotkovski: Discussion of condition of 12th Street roadway and ditches on Elm Street and Walnut Street.

Sotkovski presented the Council with pictures and a synopsis of the conditions of the streets and ditches on Walnut Street, 11th and 12th streets.

Sotkovski and the Council discussed the condition of the streets, culverts and drainage ditches on 11th, 12th and Walnut Streets.

Mayor Pence suggested having the City Engineer, Pat Cox from BG consultants look at the issues Sotkovski has presented and explore possible remedies.

Consensus of the Council was to have the Mayor contact Cox.

Jim Arp: Discussion of Chapter 13, Article 309, INJURING TREES AND SHRUBS.

Consensus of the Council wanted the Attorney to look at a time frame being placed in the proposed ordinance.

Arp moved to table the proposed change to the next meeting. Seconded by Burch. Motion carried.

Renewal of permission for Boy Scouts to use stone building in the City Park for storage of their equipment.

Carroll moved not to renew permission for the boy Scouts to use the stone building in the City Park for storage of their equipment since there is no longer a troop in Ogden and there doesn't look like there will be one in the future at this point. Seconded by Reid. Motion carried.

Bills of the Month.

Burch commented that he has reviewed the Bills of the Month and found them to be acceptable.

City Clerk: Misc. Items.

Clerk commented that Peter Rombold wanted to have a Work Session with the Council to discuss a proposed contract for the maintenance of the KDOT traffic signals.

Burch moved to have a Work Session with Peter Rombold at 6:30 p.m. at City Hall on 8/9/16. Seconded by Reid. Motion carried.

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
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Arp moved to adjourn the meeting. Seconded by Burch. Motion carried.
