

Welcome Wall Hanging Supply list

--Background fabric

2/3 yd

Cut one 15"x31" rectangle and fuse to *Fusible Fleece, and quilt using your favorite technique to within 2" of all four sides.

NOTE: if you are quilting in the hoop you will need to make this piece larger so it can be cut down later. The quilting process will shrink the fabric significantly.

Please have this done before class.

Cut Three 1 ¾" x WOF strips.

--Contrast Fabric

1/3 yd

Cut three 1 ¾" x WOF strips.

--Sparkle Organza in colors of your choice ½ yd each (I would shop the organza before the complementary fabrics as there are far fewer of these to choose from.) A clear will work as well if you don't find the colors you like.

--Green Fabric

¾ yard cut to the following size

Two 1" x WOF strip

One 3 ¼" x 13" rectangle (turn ¼" of each end to the reverse side and press, Turn under another ¼", press and then sew each hem.

Two 2 ¼" x WOF Join end to end with a mitered seam, then press in half to make the binding.

One 14" x 31" rectangle for backing

One 5" x 16" rectangle for the leaves.

--Quarter yard cuts of different colors to complement the organza.

Microtex 12 needle

Embroidery needle 14 or Purple tip

Iron, ironing pad and Teflon pressing sheet

Embroidery hoop size 6x10 or larger

¾ yard Steam a seam 24" wide

Marking pen or chalk of your choice

quilting pins and Fork pens Optional but makes your points so much easier.

Sewing thread used for quilting. I recommend Quilters Select 60wt for perfect $\frac{1}{4}$ " seams.

Embroidery threads to go with your fabrics. I used 6 colors on one and 7 on the other $\frac{1}{4}$ " foot, bilevel foot and embroidery foot.

24" ruler and cutting mat.

*Fusible Fleece used above in step one.
