

## Class Supply List: Sergers Trim Catcher

### Notions and Supplies:

- 4-Thread Serger with cords and feet
- 2 new size 90/14 needles
- Tweezers
- Scissors
- Ruler at least 6x12
- Fabric marker
- Rotary cutter and mat
- Iron for fusing interfacing: Irons will not be provided: please bring your own iron.



### Thread and Fabrics:

1/3-yard Décor Bond fusible interfacing by Pellon: this is available at Denton Sewing Center

1/3-yard good quality cotton for outside of trim catcher: a quilter's cotton works well. This is enough to make several catchers.

1/3-yard good quality cotton for inside of trim catcher. Both fabrics should be solid or small print.

2 spools of standard serger thread to match fabrics.

2 spools of decorative thread for use in loopers: I used 1 spool of Snazzy lock and 1 of wooly poly.

There are several types of thread at Denton Sewing Center that will work well in the loopers for this project.

We will have time in class to make several trim catchers: small, medium, and large. The small is great for pins or fabric clips, the medium for trims, and the large for tweezers and other tools.
