### July 4<sup>th</sup> Mylar T-shirt

#### Supply List

- Embroidery Machine with embroidery foot and power cord
- 130x180mm(5x7) or 240x150(6x9) embroidery hoop and template
- transferring embroidery

designs.

- T-shirt, tote bag, or apron to embroider.
- Fusible Poly Mesh stabilizer such as Floriani Power Mesh or No Show mesh, if you are embroidering a T-shirt, or medium tear a way if you are embroidering an apron or tote bag
- Floriani Wet n Gone stabilizer (if you are embroidering a T-shirt)
- 75/11 Embroidery Needle for T-shirt, 90/14 for apron and bag
- Embroidery thread for sewing designs: I used red, white, blue, and Floriani variegated red, white, and blue (V30)
- Bobbin thread
- Thread snips
- Tape for taping Mylar
- Tweezers
- Blue wash-out fabric marker
- Red, blue, and clear opal Mylar (If you do not have any Mylar, a kit will be available for purchase)

#### **To do before class:**

- Prewash T-shirt (recommended, otherwise, preshrink by ironing with hot steam iron)
- Open one side of tote bag so that it may be hooped easily.
