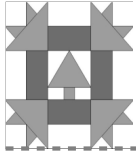

How the Shop Hop Works

Pick-up your passport at the first shop you visit. Sorry, passports cannot be stamped before Sept. 10th, 2026. Passports are available to print at sierrasewing.com/shop-hop and goingbatty.com/shop-hop

Be sure to get your passport stamped by every shop you visit. All shop hoppers must present their own passport to be stamped and will not be permitted to have more than one passport. Passports are not transferrable. Shops are only permitted to stamp passports in their designated space. If shop hoppers forget to get their passport stamped at any shop, they will have to return to that shop to get it stamped.

Turning in your fully completed passport at the end of the shop hop makes you eligible for prizes. You can turn it in at the last shop you visit, or you can mail it to: The UnCommon Thread * 1525 W. Williams Ave. Suite L * Fallon, NV 89406. The mailed passports must be postmarked no later than Sept. 16th, 2026 and must be received by Sept. 26th, 2026.

Shop Hop Prizes

Immediately turn right, east, towards I-580. Drive straight until you come to I-580 and parking lot wraps north. Going Batty is on your left.

Tips for Shop Hopping

1. If you are printing your own labels, include name, mailing address, phone number and email.
2. Wear comfortable shoes.
3. Bring a camera or cell phone.
4. Print out your Passport from the website sierrasewing.com/shop-hop or goingbatty.com/shop-hop before the first shop or keep this flier handy so that you will have phone numbers and addresses for the various shops in case you get lost or have questions. Printed passports will be available at the shops as well.
5. Don't be afraid to call a shop if you are running a little late (5-10 mins) and it's almost closing time. You'll find that in most cases the shops will be happy to wait for you; just be considerate of their time and effort.
6. If you plan on staying in a motel while hopping, reservations are recommended.
7. Be prepared to have lots of fun!
