Materials:

4" x 11 1/2" red flannel (2 pieces)
2" x 11 1/2" black strip (1)
3" x 4" white rectangle
1 1/2" x 2" gold for buckle
1/8" elastic
Two 8mm jingle bells

 Prepare black "belt" and sew down to the right side of a red flannel. Just south of center.



- Prepare white and sew over the blat belt, about 2 1/2" in from the far right.
- 3. Using two 2 1/2" squares of fusible web, use one to fuse the wrong sides of the gold together to create a thick fabric, use the other to trace the buckle template. Trace the belt template onto fusible web and iron to either side of the buckle. Cut out, fuse over the white/black intersection.
- 4. Position three two inch lengths of looped elastic on one end of the mug suit, baste into place. Attach matching buttons 1/2" in from the edge, on the other side.
- Stack the other piece of flannel on top, RST. Stitch all the way around, leaving an opening near the bottom. Turn right sides out. Whip stitch closed. Top stitch to create the finished look. Hand sew on two jingle bell buttons.
