

BAG MAKING BASICS - PART 3 - Three Vinyl Pouches

We will be making three stylish and functional vinyl zipper pouches.

The pouches are beginner friendly and make a great handmade gift.

In this skill builder tutorial you will get techniques to:

- sew better boxed bottoms
- get neat zipper corners - no dent zipper ends
- sew a zipper on a curve
- master zipper by the yard and install zipper pulls
- sew with faux leather/vinyl
- learn a new turning hole hack

Kits include the pattern pieces, vinyl, light weight lining, zippers, etc. - everything you need to make three pouches. Pattern pieces are cut and ready to sew.

The sewing notions you need to bring are listed below.

- Sewing machine in good working order with slide on tray and knee lift and bobbins.
- Polyester #40 thread Colors - white and a pale lavender color. You can use embroidery polyester thread.
- Needle: 90/14 or a 80/12 top stitch needle
- Presser feet: ¼" foot and a zipper foot. A teflon foot is helpful when sewing on vinyl.
- Small rulers - example a 3 or 4 inch square
- Wonder clips, seam ripper, stiletto
- Double sided adhesive tape - 1/8"wide - Select medium strength of hyperstik needed for zipper installation

Use 1/8" wide: : [Medium-Strength Double-Sided Basting Tape 30 yds. | WAWAKHyperstik Double-Sided Leather Basting Tape - Clear | WAWAK](#)

- sharp scissors, snips, pinking shears
- Removable markers for marking - chalk or heat erasable pen (Frixion)
- Seam roller, a lighter
- Fray check
