## CLASS SUPPLY LIST <br> BYANNIE CATCH ALL CADDY 2.0 <br> Instructor: Mary Stipanovich January 7 and 8, 2022

You will love this sturdy over-sized caddy with lots of easy-to-access slip pockets and dividers to hold and organize all your supplies.
Six slip pockets on the exterior provide easy access to tools and supplies and a zippered pocket on one end keeps personal items safe and secure.
Expanding dividers on the inside open to organize a multitude of supplies or collapse to fall flat against the interior of the caddy affording a wide-open interior for plenty of storage possibilities.
Comfy padded fabric handles make carrying easy. They attach with rectangle rings which allow them to fall flat against the front or back of the caddy.
The finished caddy measures 7"H x 13½"W x 6½"D.

## SUPPLIES NEEDED

## Pattern: Catch All Caddy 2.0 ByAnnie

Fabric: quilting cotton fabrics
1 yard - main exterior and front of bellowed dividers
1 yard - interior lining and bellowed dividers lining
1 yard - coordinating fabric for handles, binding, stabilizer sleeve
Interfacing: Soft and Stable - $1 / 2$ yard package - 58 " wide Shape Flex - $3 / 4$ yard
Zipper: 1-9" or longer handbag zipper with one pull
Strapping: $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ wide polypro strapping - any color - $1-1 / 4 y$ yard
Hardware: four $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle rings
Base Stabilizer: heavy cardboard, or plexiglass, or foam cardboard -5-3/4" $\times 12^{\prime \prime}$
Thread to Match: polyester - mettler or superior threads

## Bring all essential sewing supplies, and especially include:

90-14 top stitch needle
Zipper Foot, Walking Foot, $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ foot
Stiletto (I like ByAnnie's stiletto)
Temporary Spray Adhesive for fabric like Odif 505
Washout marking pen or pencil or Clover chalk pens
Wonder clips
Rotary cutter and mat
Rulers and small iron and pressing mat
Double sided adhesive tape, such as Wonder Tape or Dritz Wash Away - $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$
Fabric glue pen - I like Sewline
$2-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ circle ruler or use template in pattern
$12 \mathrm{~mm}\left(1 / 2^{\prime \prime}\right)$ bias tape maker - helpful for making zipper pulls

## Prior to Class Fabric Quilting

Layer pieces of main fabric, lining fabric and soft and stable for:
Side Strip - $28^{\prime \prime} \times 8^{\prime \prime}-$ No fancy quilting is necessary for this strip. Pockets cover $6^{\prime \prime}$ from the right and left short sides. Middle section can be quilted which is $6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} h$ $x$ about $14^{\prime \prime}$. After quilting cut this piece to $26-1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
Pockets - 17 " $\mathrm{h} \times 15$ " w - These pockets show so add more quilting to this piece.
After quilting cut: 2 pockets $5^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{h} \times 13-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} w$ (A and B, slip front and back pockets) and 2 pockets 5 " $h \times 6-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} w(C$ and $D$, end pockets).
Caddy Front and Back - $16^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{h} \times 15^{\prime \prime} \mathrm{w}$ - Quilt $1-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ to $2^{\prime \prime}$ lines. After quilting cut two pieces 7 "h $\times 13-1 / 2$ " $w$.

## From Main Fabric cut Divider A and B (not quilted)

A - $5-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 26-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
B-5-1/2" $\times 22-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$

## From Lining Fabric cut Divider A and B (not quilted)

A - $6-1 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 26-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
B-6-1/4" $\times 22-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
(Divider A and B are made of main and lining fabric with lining fabric folded around to make a faux binding. Divider $A$ is attached to the inside of the Caddy Front and Divider $B$ is attached to the inside of the Caddy Back)

## From woven interfacing cut:

One $5^{\prime \prime} \times 24-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ for A and one $5^{\prime \prime} \times 20-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ for B
From Coordinating Fabric (not quilted) cut:
Stabilizer sleeve - $16-1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 13-1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$
Handle Tabs - $3-3 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{\prime \prime}$ - cut 4
Handles - 6" x 20" - cut 2
Bindings for pockets - 3 strips - $2^{\prime \prime} w x$ width of fabric

## From Soft and Stable only cut

Two pieces $1-3 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 19^{\prime \prime}$
From 1-1/2" strapping cut four pieces 10" each Bias binding can be cut later
