### CLASS SUPPLY LIST BYANNIE CATCH ALL CADDY 2.0

Instructor: Mary Stipanovich January 7 and 8, 2022

You will love this sturdy over-sized caddy with lots of easy-to-access slip pockets and dividers to hold and organize all your supplies.

Six slip pockets on the exterior provide easy access to tools and supplies and a zippered pocket on one end keeps personal items safe and secure.

Expanding dividers on the inside open to organize a multitude of supplies or collapse to fall flat against the interior of the caddy affording a wide-open interior for plenty of storage possibilities.

Comfy padded fabric handles make carrying easy. They attach with rectangle rings which allow them to fall flat against the front or back of the caddy.

The finished caddy measures  $7"H \times 13\%"W \times 6\%"D$ .

#### **SUPPLIES NEEDED**

Pattern: Catch All Caddy 2.0 ByAnnie

**Fabric:** quilting cotton fabrics

1 yard - main exterior and front of bellowed dividers1 yard - interior lining and bellowed dividers lining

1 yard - coordinating fabric for handles, binding, stabilizer sleeve

Interfacing: Soft and Stable - ½ yard package - 58" wide

Shape Flex - ¾ yard

**Zipper:** 1 - 9" or longer handbag zipper with one pull

**Strapping:** 1-1/2" wide polypro strapping - any color - 1-1/4yard

**Hardware:** four 1-1/2" rectangle rings

**Base Stabilizer:** heavy cardboard, or plexiglass, or foam cardboard - 5-3/4" x 12"

**Thread to Match:** polyester - mettler or superior threads

## Bring all essential sewing supplies, and especially include:

90-14 top stitch needle

Zipper Foot, Walking Foot, ¼" foot

Stiletto (I like ByAnnie's stiletto)

Temporary Spray Adhesive for fabric like Odif 505

Washout marking pen or pencil or Clover chalk pens

Wonder clips

Rotary cutter and mat

Rulers and small iron and pressing mat

Double sided adhesive tape, such as Wonder Tape or Dritz Wash Away - 1/4"

Fabric glue pen - I like Sewline

2-1/2" circle ruler or use template in pattern

12mm (1/2") bias tape maker - helpful for making zipper pulls

#### **Prior to Class Fabric Quilting**

Layer pieces of main fabric, lining fabric and soft and stable for:

**Side Strip** -  $28" \times 8"$  - No fancy quilting is necessary for this strip. Pockets cover 6" from the right and left short sides. Middle section can be quilted which is  $6-\frac{1}{2}"$  h x about 14". After quilting cut this piece to  $26-\frac{1}{4}" \times 6-\frac{1}{2}"$ 

**Pockets -** 17"h x 15"w - These pockets show so add more quilting to this piece.

After quilting cut: 2 pockets  $5''h \times 13-\frac{1}{2}''w$  (A and B, slip front and back pockets) and 2 pockets  $5''h \times 6-\frac{1}{2}''w$  (C and D, end pockets).

**Caddy Front and Back** - 16"h x 15"w - Quilt  $1-\frac{1}{2}$ " to 2" lines. After quilting cut two pieces 7"h x  $13-\frac{1}{2}$ "w.

#### From Main Fabric cut Divider A and B (not quilted)

A - 5-1/2" x 26-1/2"

B - 5-1/2" x 22-1/2"

#### From Lining Fabric cut Divider A and B (not quilted)

A - 6-1/4" x 26-1/2"

B - 6-1/4" x 22-1/2"

(Divider A and B are made of main and lining fabric with lining fabric folded around to make a faux binding. Divider A is attached to the inside of the Caddy Front and Divider B is attached to the inside of the Caddy Back)

#### From woven interfacing cut:

One 5" x 24-1/2" for A and one 5" x 20-1/2" for B

#### From Coordinating Fabric (not quilted) cut:

Stabilizer sleeve - 16-1/2" x 13-1/2"

Handle Tabs - 3-34" x 12" - cut 4

Handles - 6" x 20" - cut 2

Bindings for pockets - 3 strips - 2"w x width of fabric

#### From Soft and Stable only cut

Two pieces 1-3/8" x 19"

# From 1-1/2" strapping cut four pieces 10" each

Bias binding can be cut later
