

CLASS SUPPLY LIST FOR FOLDILOCKS, a ByAnnie.com pattern

Pattern: ByAnnie.com - Foldilocks

Choose a size: small or large

Use cotton fabrics: A directional fabric can be used for the pockets but a non-directional fabric for the body of the bag is recommended.

Outer Pockets: one fat quarter for the main fabric and one fat quarter for the pocket lining Additional fabric for fussy cutting is needed if using a directional fabric.

Coordinating fabric: $\frac{5}{8}$ yard for the body, pocket bindings, tabs, and strap

ByAnnie Soft and Stable: 12 x 10 for small 14 x 12 for large

Fusible woven interfacing: - $\frac{1}{2}$ to $\frac{3}{4}$ yard - Pellon Shape Flex

Handbag zippers - #5 nylon - small requires one 16" and two zipper pulls
Large size requires one 18" and two zipper pulls.

Consider zipper tape by the yard. You will need one yard and four zipper pulls to make a small and large. #5 zipper tape shopping:

ByAnnie Tool-Free Snaps - two sets

ByAnnie Sew-in magnetic snaps - one set

Optional 1" wide hardware for carrying strap:

2 one inch wide swivel hooks and 1 one inch wide wide mouth slider

Also needed for carrying strap is 1" wide poly webbing: 58" long

Supplies:

Sewing machine with slide on tray and knee lift

90-14 top stitch needle and thread to match fabrics

Zipper Foot, $\frac{1}{4}$ " foot

Stiletto (I like ByAnnie's stiletto)

Removable marking pens or chalk pens

Wonder clips, rotary cutter, small quilting ruler
Double sided tape for fabric: $\frac{1}{8}$ " or $\frac{1}{4}$ " wide
Fabric turning tool and a bodkin - helpful for a carrying strap
Glue pen such as Sewline Glue Pen

Prior to Class:

Cut main and lining fabric and soft and stable for the exterior pockets

See page two of the pattern for the cutting chart.

Notice that the cutting is the same for the main fabric, the lining fabric and the soft and stable. Cut one from main fabric, one from lining fabric and one from soft and stable.

Small: 12h x 10w Large: 14h x 12w

Then quilt the pockets. See page 1 of pattern for general quilting instructions.

Place a lining piece wrong side up, place soft and stable on top, and then place the main fabric right side up to make a quilt sandwich. Pin to hold together.

Quilt the pieces. Annie suggests that you quilt straight lines about $\frac{3}{4}$ " to 1" apart vertically from top to bottom. Or quilt diagonal lines or quilt as desired.

From the just quilted fabric cut the quilted pockets for the size you have chosen.

Small size: cut two 5"h x 8- $\frac{1}{2}$ "w

Large size: cut two 6"h x 10"w

From coordinating fabric cut:

Body Front and Back: Small: two 8- $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 22" Large: two 10" x 26- $\frac{1}{2}$ "

Pocket Bindings: two 2" x 9" (small) two 2" x 11" (large)

For either size cut:

Strap Tabs: two 2" x 3- $\frac{1}{4}$ " Side tabs: four 3" x 1- $\frac{1}{2}$ "

Zipper tabs: one 5" x 1- $\frac{1}{4}$ "

From fusible interfacing:

Body interfacing: two 21" x 7- $\frac{1}{2}$ " (small) two 25- $\frac{1}{2}$ x 9" (large)

For either size cut:

Strap tabs: two 1" x 2- $\frac{3}{4}$ " Side tabs: four 1- $\frac{1}{2}$ x 1"

Zipper tabs: one 5" x 1- $\frac{1}{4}$ "

Also cut two pieces 1- $\frac{1}{4}$ x 1- $\frac{1}{4}$ for magnet covers
