

## **Class Supply List for Under Cover**

Two day class. March 25 - 10:30 to 4:30 and March 26- 10:30 to 1:00

**Supplies Needed: Pattern: Under Cover ByAnnie.com**

**Fabric:** Quilt weight cotton. - Choose three fabrics

Directional fabric is fine for this project.

Main fabric for the body and pockets - 1-1/2 yd for small and medium  
2-1/2 yd for a large size

Lining fabric - same as the main fabric

Coordinating fabric for binding, facings - 3/4 yd for small and med. - 1 yd for lg.

**Interfacing:** ByAnnie Soft and Stable - 1 yd for sm, - 1-1/4 for med. - 1-1/2 for lg.

Shape Flex, woven fusible interfacing - 1/2 yd for all sizes

**Sew in magnetic snap - two snaps sets - ByAnnie**

**Thread to complement fabrics**

**Option: Mesh fabric for pocket - 10 x 12 for sm. and med.- 11 x 12 for large**  
**Fold over elastic - 1/4 yd. (for mesh pocket binding)**

**Option: Nylon double slide handbag zipper #5 or #4.5 for zippered pocket**  
**30" long for small and 40" long for medium and large**

### **Bring all essential sewing supplies to include:**

Sewing machine in good working order with slide on tray and knee lift

90/14 top stitch needle

Presser feet: Zipper foot, 1/4" foot and a walking foot may be helpful

Small rulers for marking placement lines

Stiletto (I like ByAnnie's stiletto) and Wonder clips are essential

Rotary cutter, scissors, snips

Circular ruler - 2-1/2" or use template provided in pattern - I'll have this

Removable markers for marking - chalk or pen

Fabric glue pen and double sided adhesive tape for sewing is helpful.

### **Prior to Class please cut and quilt fabrics.**

Follow the directions on page 2 of the pattern to measure your machine - height, width and depth. Compare your machine's measurement to the measurement listed in the pattern for a small, medium or large size. Check out the add-on video tutorial at [ByAnnie.com](http://ByAnnie.com) for help in determining size.

Sandwich the fabrics and soft and stable. Place the lining face down, add the soft and stable and place the main fabric up. Pin or spray baste to hold.

Refer to the cutting chart at the bottom of page 2.

You will need to cut Set A for the front and back of the cover.

**Note:** If you are not adding pockets, you do not need Set B.

For Set C you will need to cut left and right side strips and front and back flaps.

You can use contrast fabrics for this. (See the cutting section on page 4. For example, if you want contrast flaps for a medium size cut your main, lining and soft and stable 6-1/2 x 16-1/2. Then quilt and cut using the pattern measurement.

**Quilt each set as desired. Refer to the General Quilting Instructions on page 1 of the pattern or tutorials at [ByAnnie.com/tutorials](http://ByAnnie.com/tutorials).**

Please wait for class to cut your quilted pieces.

There are options to add a zippered pocket with a border to hold your manual (Pocket A), a quilted slip pocket to hold your slide on tray (Pocket B), a small zippered side pocket to store tools (Pocket C), and a mesh pocket to store your foot pedal (Pocket D).

**From coordinating fabric (not quilted), Press fabric before cutting.**

**If you are adding pockets you need pocket bindings (not bias)**

Small and Medium: cut 2 strips 2" wide by width of fabric - 3 strips 2" wide for large

**If you want to add a border, cut a border 3" - 4" wide - Need one**

Length is 17" for small, 19-1/2" for medium, and 22" for large.

**(these dimensions will change if you altered the width of your cover)**

**The border will need interfacing. Use the border measurement above.**

**For flap facings you need two pieces:**

**Small: 4-3/4 x 13-3/4 - med. 5-1/2 x 15-1/2 - large: 5-1/2 x 18-1/4**

**Flap facings require interfacing - cut two using the dimensions above.**

You can wait to cut the bias binding in class. You will need continuous bias binding that is 2-1/4" wide. You will need approximately 5 to 6 yards.
