

## **Class Supply List for Get Out of Town Duffle 2.0**

Class Dates: September 26 and 27, 2025

Day before for cutting help: September 25 at 4 pm

**Pattern:** Get Out of Town Duffle 2.1 ByAnnie.com

Also known as Get out of Town 2.0 and Get out of Town Duffle II

### **Fabric:**

1 yard of main fabric for body of bag, pockets and carrying strap pad

1 yard of lining fabric for lining bag body, ends, pockets, etc.

1-¼ yard of coordinating fabric for bindings, handle, pulls, inner pocket, etc.

This pattern is recommended for non-directional fabrics. If you choose to use directional fabrics refer to page 2 of the pattern - "Tip" under Section I. A. Cut.

**Foam Stabilizer:** 1 yard of ByAnnie's Soft and Stable

**Mesh fabric:** 7" x 18" - for the inner pocket - optional

**Fold over elastic - one package** - for the inner pocket - optional

**Handbag Zippers:** #4.5 or #5 nylon handbag zippers

One 10" or longer single slide for exterior pocket

One 24" or longer double slide for body of bag

If using zipper tape by the yard you need one yard and 3 zipper pulls.

**Interfacing:** 1/2 yard of Shapeflex fusible woven interfacing - Pellon SF-101

Or use Wovenfuse1 - Gotinterfacing.com

**Strapping:** 1 inch wide polyester webbing/strapping - 5-½ yards

### **One Inch Hardware:**

1" triangle rings - need 2

1" swivel hooks - need 2

1" wide mouth slider - need 1

**Base Stabilizer:** BS-120 base stabilizer 6" x 14-¾" Debbie can order.

**2-½" circle ruler - or use the 2-½" circle template** provided in pattern or

### **Bring all essential sewing supplies, including:**

Sewing machine tray and knee lift if available

90/14 top stitch needle

Thread - #40 polyester - match fabrics

Presser Feet: zipper, walking Foot, ¼" foot

Stiletto (I like ByAnnie's stiletto)

Removable marking pen or pencil or chalk pens

Wonder clips, pins

Rotary cutter, scissors, snips

Double sided adhesive tape - ByAnnie's 1/8" wide for zippers and more

Use 1/4" wide double sided basting tape for adhering straps, tabs, etc.

Fabric turning tool and bodkin - needed for making straps

Fabric glue pen is helpful - I like Sewline

12mm (1/2") bias tape maker - helpful for making zipper pulls (optional)

**Prior to Class please quilt your fabric (main and lining) and foam stabilizer.**

To quilt the pieces, sandwich the 3 pieces - lining fabric wrong side up, soft and stable, and then the main fabric right side up.

Cut one 36 x 20" from each of the main fabric, the lining fabric and the ByAnnie Soft and Stable

If the main or lining fabric is directional cut two pieces 18-1/2 x 20". See pattern page 2 under A. Tip. This is quilted and will be the bag body.

Cut another one 36" x 18" from each of the main fabric, the lining fabric and the ByAnnie Soft and Stable

This is quilted and multiple components (front and back pockets, ends and end pockets and strap pad) will be cut after it is quilted.

**Refer to the general quilting instructions on page 1 of the pattern .**

- Always press fabric and foam to remove wrinkles.
- A temporary fabric adhesive spray (Odif 505) can be a substitute for pins to hold the layers together.
- Use a longer machine stitch length and use a walking foot.
- Pattern suggests quilting straight lines about 1" apart from top to bottom or in a diagonal grid.

Or free motion quilt these pieces in any design you prefer.

Or ask a longarm quilter to quilt the 1 yard pieces of the main and lining fabric with the soft and stable.

**Note: Need help with cutting. Come the day before (September 25) at 4 pm. Bring your quilted fabric, coordinating fabric, rotary cutter and mat.**

## Cut the Quilted Fabrics and Seal Edges

### **Cut the 36 x 20 Quilted Fabric:**

Using the 36 x 20 quilted fabric, cut the bag body. 33" h x 17"w.

### **Cut the 36 x 18 Quilted Fabric:**

Using the 36 x 18 quilted fabric, cut the following:

Two - 10- $\frac{1}{2}$  x 7- $\frac{1}{2}$ "w - bag ends

Two - 6- $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 7- $\frac{1}{2}$ "w - end pockets

Two - 6- $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 7" w - front pocket B and back pocket C

One - 5" x 7"w - front zipper pocket A

Two - 8- $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2- $\frac{1}{2}$ " - strap pad

One - 6- $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 2-12" - strap pad

Stitch around each quilted piece approximately  $\frac{1}{8}$ " from the edges.

### **Cut coordinating fabric:**

1. The handle, carrying strap and tabs are 2- $\frac{3}{4}$ " wide.

Cut 3 strips 2- $\frac{3}{4}$  x 42 or the width of fabric.

Cut 1 strip 2- $\frac{3}{4}$  x 22

Cut 1 strip 2- $\frac{3}{4}$  x 20

2. For the pocket border and bindings that are two inches wide cut two strips that are 2"wide x the width of fabric.

From these strips cut the following lengths:

5 strips that are 2"w x 8" long

2 strips that are 2"w x 3" long

3. Stabilizer sleeve - 14" x 20" - cut 1

4. Inner Pocket - 13" x 17" - cut 1

Bias binding is 2- $\frac{1}{4}$ " wide and you need approx. 4 yards of continuous bias binding. Need help with bias binding or mesh, wait to cut that in class.

**Use the labels provided** in the pattern to help you keep track of the pieces.

**Class registration policy:** All classes must be paid for at the time of registration. If a class is canceled due to a lack of minimum enrollment, the class fee will be refunded. Any cancellation must be made at least 72 hours in advance to receive a refund. Teachers need time to prepare class handouts and supplies. Please register early as possible to ensure your place and to avoid disappointment. **Please have working knowledge of your machine as the educator will not have time to instruct on the use of your machine**
