## THREE VINYL POUCHES CLASS SUPPLY LIST

All Vinyl is cut for each project and zippers with pulls are included.

Some color variations may differ from the store samples.

You will need to bring:

**Sewing machine** in good working condition with tray and a knee lift if you have one. **Presser Feet**  $-\frac{1}{4}$ " foot, zipper foot, a teflon foot and walking foot if you have one **For successful sewing on vinyl** it is very important that you have a teflon foot, or a non-stick foot, or a roller foot.

**Thread** - use 100 percent polyester thread - Mettler 40 wt polyester or the Isacord #40 embroidery thread found at Bernina

For the top thread have an assortment of colors: light blue, light purple, light pink, aqua, violet, black

**For your bobbin** choose a neutral color (off white or light gray color)

Machine Needles - 80/12, 90/14 (universal or top stitch)

Look for a vinyl needle or non stick needle - check with Bernina for

Schmetz Super Universal Non Stick Home Machine Needles - size 12 or 14.

Helpful to have an assortment of needles to choose from

Double sided adhesive tape - 1/8" wide ByAnnie - find it at Bernina

Pencil, Marking pen

Wonder clips and Stiletto

Scissors and snips

**Silicone mat or teflon pressing mat** - helpful to have on the bed of your machine to prevent vinyl sticking - Or use large post it pad or tissue paper

I'll have the following items to use but feel free to include it with your supplies.

A small rubber mallet and a seam roller to help flatten seams

Painter's tape

Lighter to seal zipper tape edge

Hair dryer to soften vinyl for turning

I will also have an assortment of thread colors
