

FABRIC and VINYL GIFT BAGS for Holiday Gift Giving Class Supply List

For the Fabric Fold-over Gift Bags: Choose 100% cotton for main, lining and contrast fabrics. See cutting chart below for fabric requirements

Interfacing: ShapeFlex - Pellon SF101, a fusible woven lightweight interfacing. Get 2 yards. It is 20" wide.

Fusible fleece interfacing: Pellon - Thermolam, TP971 Fusible - get 1 yard

Ribbon - 1/4", 3/8" or 1/2" wide 3/8" - colors to coordinate with your fabric

Supplies Needed:

Point turner - A favorite is RNK Turning Tool

Small rulers - 3-4" square or a 2x 8

Marking pens, straight pins and wonder clips

Polyester thread to match fabrics

Presser feet: 1/4" foot, zipper foot, teflon foot and an edge foot are helpful

Sewing machine needle: 80/12 and a 90/14

Rotary cutter, scissors, and other miscellaneous sewing notions

Use spray starch and press fabrics before cutting.

CUTTING CHART: Measurement is Width x Height

Small size:

2 - 8.5w x 6.5 main fabric top

2 - 8.5w x 4.5 main contrast fabric bottom

2 - 8.5 w x 10.5 lining fabric

2 - 8 x 10 fusible fleece

Medium size:

2 - 10w x 9 main fabric top

2 - 10w x 6 main contrast fabric bottom

2 - 10w x 14.5h lining fabric

2 - 9.5w x 14h fusible fleece

Large size:

2 - 14w x 9.5 main fabric top

2 - 14w x 8.5 main contrast fabric bottom

2 - 14w x 17.5h lining fabric

2 - 13.5 x 17h fusible fleece

All materials to make the vinyl tote bags and gift card case are included.

Written instructions for each project will be provided in class.

Please have working knowledge of your machine as the educator will not have time to instruct on the use of your machine. **Class registration policy:** All classes must be paid for at the time of registration.
