Class Supply List for Open Wide Bag 2.0

Instructor: Mary Stipanovich

Description: Quick and fun to make. These handy zippered bags in three sizes *Open Wide* for easy access to all your supplies. Binding on the zipper finishes the upper edges and forms a handle and grab tab. Optional mesh pockets keep things organized and easy to view.

Pattern: Open Wide 2.0 ByAnnie.com

If you are new to ByAnnie patterns, choose the medium or large size.

Supplies:

Fabric for Medium or Large:

1/2 yard of main fabric and 1/2 yard for lining

1/2 yard of coordinating fabric for border, binding, handle, etc.

Note: The front border requires fabric $4^{-1/2}$ " x $10^{-1/2}$ " for the medium

The large size is $5-\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12". You could choose ribbon, cork, trim, etc.

Mesh fabric for Inner Pockets: medium - 12" x 12" large - 16" x 14"

Fabric could be substituted for the inner pockets.

Zipper:

Use handbag zippers - #5

For medium size - 15" or longer.

For large size - 18" or longer.

Foam Stabilizer:

1/2 yard of ByAnnie's Soft and Stable

Interfacing:

1/4 yard of Shapeflex fusible woven interfacing - Pellon SF-101

Fold Over Elastic for binding inner pockets: 1-1/2 yards

Bring all essential sewing supplies, and especially include:

90 top stitch needle

Thread #50 polyester

Zipper, Walking Foot, 1/4" foot

Stiletto (I like ByAnnie's stiletto)

Temporary Spray Adhesive for fabric like Odif 505

Washout marking pen or pencil or Clover chalk pens

Wonder clips

Rotary cutter

Double sided adhesive tape

Fabric glue pen - I like Sewline

12mm ($\frac{1}{2}$ ") bias tape maker - helpful for making zipper pulls

PRIOR TO CLASS FABRIC QUILTING

For the MEDIUM size, layer Main fabric, soft and stable and Lining fabric as follows:

For the bag body – $12^{-1/2}$ " x 20" of main, lining and soft and stable For the ends – $8^{-1/2}$ " x 12" of main, lining and soft and stable Quilt as desired. Pattern suggests quilting vertical lines 1" apart or quilting diagonal lines in a crosshatch pattern. Refer to page 1 of the pattern.

After quilting: Cut bag body 18" x 10-1/2"

Cut ends $6-\frac{1}{2}$ " x 5" - you need two ends

For the LARGE size, layer main fabric, soft and stable and lining fabric as follows:

For the bag body - 14" x 26" of main, lining and soft and stable For the ends - 11" x 14" of main, lining and soft and stable Quilt as desired. Pattern suggests quilting vertical lines 1" apart or quilting diagonal lines in a crosshatch pattern. Refer to page 1 of the pattern.

After quilting: Cut bag body 24" x 12"

Cut ends 9" x 6" - you need two ends

Stitch around each piece about 1/8" from the edge.

For cutting the coordinating fabric, see page 2 of the pattern.

Class registration policy: All classes must be paid for at the time of registration. If a class is canceled due to a lack of minimum enrollment, the class fee will be refunded. Any cancellation must be made at least 72 hours in advance to receive a refund. Teachers need time to prepare class handouts and supplies. Please register early as possible to ensure your place and to avoid disappointment.
