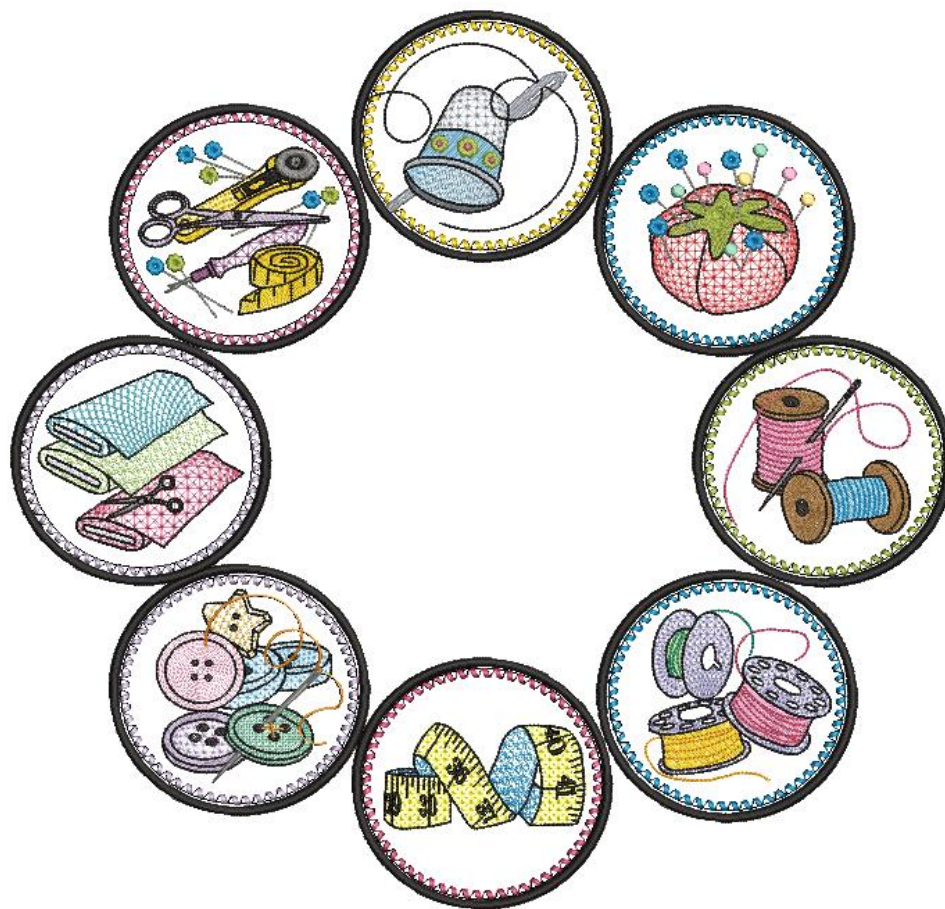

SEWING ESSENTIALS COASTERS

Supply List

These 8 Sewing Coasters are completely embroidered and finished in the hoop!

Fabric Supply List:

- 1/3 yard White or Cream tone on tone Background Fabric (cut into 6"x6" squares)
- 1/3 yard Colorful Fabric for the backing (cut into 6"x6" squares)
- ½ yard Fusible Fleece or (8) 4 ½" Bosal rounds

Embroidery Supply List:

- Minimum Stitch Field Required 5"x5
- Aqua Mesh Stabilizer (water soluble mesh) or Aqua Mesh Plus (water soluble & sticky backed)
- Basic embroidery kit including small doubled curved scissors & pointy tweezers
- Embroidery needles 80/20
- Applique Scissors

FABRIC PREPARATION

Wash the fabric to remove extra dye.

Background Fabric: (Top side of Coaster)

Starch the fabric.

Cut the prepared **Background Fabric** into 6" x 6" squares (one for each coaster)

Fusible Fleece:

Print the circle shape from the **Template Folder** on cardstock or heavier paper. Use this as your template. Place the paper template on several layers of the fleece and cut the circle shape out. The template is slightly smaller than the actual size needed. Make 4 circle shapes for each coaster: 2 circles for the top and 2 circles for the bottom or use one pre-cut 4 ½" Bosal round instead of the fleece.

Backing Fabric:

Cut the prepared **Backing Fabric** into 6" x 6" squares (one for each coaster)

Embroidery Instructions: (Background Fabric)

- Sew Color #1 the Placement Line on the Aqua Mesh Stabilizer (no fabric in the hoop just the stabilizer).
- Center two cut circle shapes of **Fusible Fleece** over the circle shaped placement line.
- On wrong side of the **Background Fabric** spray a dot of adhesive spray in each corner.
- Flip the **Background Fabric** right side up and center it over the circle fleece shapes.
- Carefully hold the fabric in place while you embroider the tackdown stitch so the fabric doesn't shift.
- Embroider the top of the coaster following the instructions.

Embroidery Instructions: (Backing Fabric)

- Remove the hoop from the module and flip to the wrong side
- Center two cut circles over the outline of the coaster design (not necessary if you use the Bosal)
- On wrong side of the **Backing Fabric** spray a dot of adhesive spray in each corner
- Cover the fleece circles with the **Backing Fabric** right side up.
- Re-attach the hoop to the module and continue following the embroidery instructions.

Note:

1. Cutting the fleece first will make trimming the fabric much easier.
2. I do not have you "pre-cut" the circle shape of **fabric** because of the amount of embroidery on the top of each coaster will likely pull the fabric to the center causing the satin cover stitch to "miss the edge of the Background Fabric.
3. I also have available 4 ½" Bosal pre-cut rounds to use instead of the fleece.



FINISHING TOUCHES

When the embroidery is complete:

Remove the aqua mesh stabilizer from the hoop and trim away the excess aqua mesh stabilizer staying ¼" away from the satin stitches. Fill a sink half full of water and soak the coasters for 5-10 minutes to remove the aqua mesh inside the coaster. I like to gently rub the back of the coaster to help make the aqua mesh dissolve. Rinse & drain the water and squeeze out the coasters. Lay flat on a counter (ha! they will curl up). Let them dry. When dry, trim any wild threads you may have missed. Be careful not to cut the satin stitches. Place each coaster upside down on the ironing board and cover with a pressing cloth. Press flat as a pancake with a **hot steam** iron.

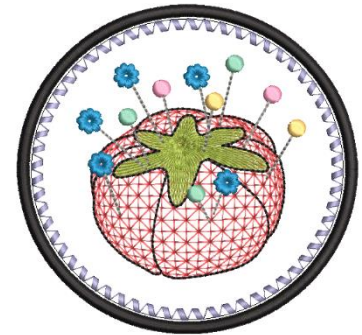

Embroider Color #2 making sure the fabric lays flat and smooth. It will embroider the double run tackdown then the decorative border. **DO NOT TRIM THE FABRIC!!** If you cut the circle shape it may pull away from the edge and the satin cover stitch may not catch the fabric.

Embroider two pin heads.

Thread Color #4 Country Red # _____

Embroider the tomato pincushion.

Thread Color #5 Pear Green # _____

Embroider the leaves.

Thread Color #6 Black # _____

Embroider the outline of the design.

Thread Color #7 Metal # _____

Embroider the straight pins.

Thread Color #8 Apple Green # _____

Embroider three pin heads.

Thread Color #9 Daisy # _____

Embroider two pin heads.

Thread Color #10 Pacific Blue # _____

Embroider the flower pin heads.

Change the bobbin thread color to black. Remove the hoop and flip wrong side up. Center two fleece circles over the outline of the coaster. If you used the 4 ½ pre-cut Bosal no additional fleece or Bosal is needed. Cover with the **Background Fabric** (right side up). **DO NOT TRIM THE FABRIC IN A CIRCLE SHAPE.** Re-attach the hoop

Thread Color #11 Black # _____

Embroider the Double Run Tackdown. Remove the hoop from the module (not the fabric from the hoop) and turn the hoop upside down and trim the excess fabric **right up to the stitch line on the back then turn over and trim the front.** Do not leave any extra fabric showing outside the stitch line. Return the hoop to the module

Thread Color #12 Black # _____

Embroider the cover stitch around the coaster. Refer to **Finishing Touches** on page #3.



2 Thimble

 Hoop one piece of Aqua Mesh stabilizer. (No fabric just the Aqua Mesh)
 Attach the hoop to the module.

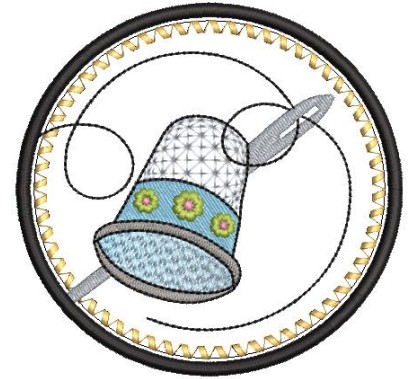
Thread Color #1 Daisy # _____

Placement Line:

Sew the placement line on the Aqua Mesh.

The color on the screen is black but you will be using Daisy.

Center two fleece circles or one Bosal round over the placement line. Cover with the Background Fabric right side up. **DO NOT TRIM THE FABRIC IN A CIRCLE SHAPE.**



Thread Color #2 Daisy # _____

Double Run Tackdown & Decorative Border:

Embroider Color #2 making sure the fabric lays flat and smooth. It will embroider the double run

tackdown then decorative border. **DO NOT TRIM THE FABRIC!!** If you cut the circle shape it may pull away from the edge and the satin cover stitch may not catch the fabric.

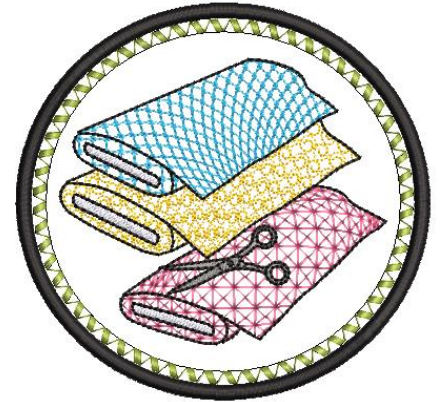

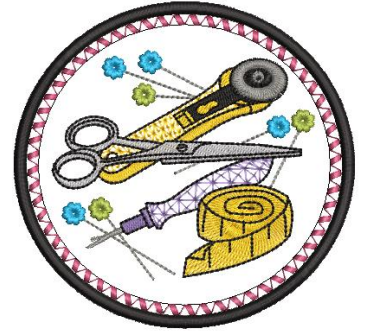
