This is a great class for those who took the Beginning Quilting class and want the next step. It is a fairly simple block and can be done with or without the Tucker Trimmer tool. Of course you know which I prefer, but you will have a chance to try both methods.

Above are just a few suggestions for you for our 5" finished Half Square Triangle blocks. You may want to come up with your own design.

Sewing Supplies:

Tucker Trimmer I (optional) **Quilter's Magic Wand (optional)** 6 x 24 (approximate) Ruler **Rotary Cutter** Mat

Sewing Machine in good working order

Sewing supplies you like to use - 1/4" foot, thread, bobbins, glass head pins, seam ripper, scissors, sewing machine needles, etc.

Backing	3 yards	2 1/2 yards
Binding	1/2 yard	1/2 yard
