

ZIP IT UP 2.0 CLASS SUPPLY LIST

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Pattern: Zip it Up 2.0 ByAnnie.com

Fabric: Choose quilt weight cotton. - Choose three fabrics

Directional fabric is fine for this project. Because hardly any of the fabric of the exterior case body shows, save your fussy cutting for the exterior pockets.

Exterior pockets for the small case measure 8"h x 10"w after quilting.

Exterior pockets for the large case measure 11"h x 14"w after quilting.

For the Small Case

Main exterior fabric, lining fabric and coordinating fabric - 1/2 yard each

For the Large Case

Main exterior fabric, lining fabric and coordinating fabric - 3/4 yard each

Additional fabric may be needed for directional fabrics.

Note: If this is your first time making Zip it Up, I suggest you make the large.

Interfacing: ByAnnie Soft and Stable - 1/2 yard for small or large size

Shape Flex , a woven fusible interfacing - 10" x 15

Vinyl or Mesh for the inner pockets - ByAnnie Premium vinyl and ByAnnie Mesh - choose mesh or vinyl or both.

Polyester Strapping - 1" wide - 3/4 yard

Fold over Elastic - ByAnnie - 3/4 yard

Double Sided Adhesive Tape for sewing - 1/8" wide - ByAnnie

Thread to complement fabrics and zipper tape

Nylon Handbag Zippers: #5 or #4.5

Zipper Pulls - 6 zipper pulls for small or large if using zipper by the yard

For the small: 2-1/2 yards of zipper tape or use

One 24" single slide zipper and three 30" double slide zippers

For the large: 3-1/2 yards of zipper tape or use

One 24" single slide zipper and three 40" double slide zippers

Bring all essential sewing supplies to include:

Sewing machine in good working order with slide on tray and knee lift

90/14 top stitch needle

Presser feet: Zipper foot, 1/4" foot and a nonstick (teflon) foot

Walking foot is helpful.

Small rulers for marking placement lines

Stiletto (I like ByAnnie's stiletto)

Wonder clips are essential and SewTites magnetic pins are optional

Rotary cutter and small mat

Circular ruler - 2-1/2" or use template provided in pattern - I'll have this

Removable markers for marking - chalk or pen

Fabric turning tool and bodkin, small rulers, scissors and snips

Fabric glue pen - I like Sewline

Prior to Class please cut and quilt fabrics.

Measurements are height by width

Sandwich the fabrics and soft and stable. Place lining face down, add the soft and stable and place main fabric up. Pin or spray baste to hold.

For the Small Case cut two sets:

Set A: 12" x 20" of main and lining fabrics and soft and stable

Set B: 18" x 12" of main and lining fabrics and soft and stable

For the Large Case cut two sets:

Set A: 16" x 26" of main and lining fabrics and soft and stable

Set B: 24" x 16" of main and lining fabrics and soft and stable.

Note: Set A is for the case body and Set B is for two outer pockets.

Quilt each set as desired. Refer to the General Quilting Instructions on page 1 of the pattern or tutorials at ByAnnie.com/tutorials.

Cut the Quilted Pieces: (height x width)

For the Small Case

From Set A cut the Case Body - 10" x 18"

From Set B cut the outer front and back pockets - 8"x 10" (cut two)

For the Large Case

From Set A cut the Case Body - 14" x 24"

From Set B cut the outer front and back pockets - 11"x 14" (cut two)

  **Stitch around each quilted piece 1/8" from the edge.**

From Coordinating Fabric (not quilted)

Press fabric before cutting. Attach labels to pieces as you go.

Pocket Bindings (not bias)

Small: cut two strips 2" wide by width of fabric

Large: cut four strips 2" wide by width of fabric

(we cut this into smaller lengths in class)

Outer Front Pocket Border: Small - $2\frac{1}{4}$ " x 10" Large - 3" x 14"

Option to change the width of the border or eliminate border

Handle: Small: $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " (cut one) and $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x 10" (cut one)

Large: $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x $14\frac{1}{2}$ " (cut one) and $2\frac{3}{4}$ " x 14" (cut one)

Center Facing: - 10" x $3\frac{1}{4}$ " for small - 14" x $3\frac{1}{4}$ " for large

Inner Pocket Facings: Small - $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 9" (cut two)

Large - $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12" (cut two)

Cut Fusible Interfacing: (Shape Flex)

Center Facing: small - $3\frac{1}{4}$ " x 10" large - $3\frac{1}{4}$ " x 14"

Outer Pocket Border: small - $1\frac{3}{4}$ " x $9\frac{1}{2}$ " large - $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $13\frac{1}{2}$ "

Inner Pocket Facings: small - 1" x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " (cut 2) - large 1" x $11\frac{1}{2}$ " (cut 2)

Vinyl and Mesh - wait to cut in class if not sure

Note: For the interior pockets, the pattern shows the single inner pocket made of mesh and the inner double pockets made of vinyl. You can use either material or only one for your inner pockets.

Small: Inner Single Pocket - 9" x 9" (cut one)

Inner Double Pockets - $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x 9" (cut two)

Large: Inner Single Pocket - 13" x 12" (cut one)

Inner Double Pockets - $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12" (cut two)

Cut Polyester Webbing/Strapping for Handle

Small: $9\frac{1}{2}$ " long and 9" long

Large: $13\frac{1}{2}$ " long and 13" long

Cut Foldover Elastic - for the center facing storage options

Note: Press elastic with an iron on a low to medium setting before cutting.

Cut five strips for small and seven strips for large - $3\frac{1}{2}$ " long each.
