

Kimberbell Machine Embroider by Number Supply List

- Any Kimberbell Machine Embroider by Numbers CD
 - Cut away stabilizer
 - Curved embroidery scissors or applique scissors
 - Thread snips
 - Pressing tool options (iron or fabric folding pen)
 - Small iron that can fit inside your hoop & an ironing surface (be careful if your batting has polyester that it doesn't melt with an iron)
- OR**
- Clover Fabric Folding Pen – you may wish to use this instead of an iron
 - Embroidery capable machine with embroidery module and the following:
 - Embroidery hoop capable of stitching the size of the design you choose
 - Embroidery foot (Bernina #26)
 - Embroidery needle size 90/14 (new needle would be best)
 - Embroidery bobbin case with bobbin thread
 - Power Cord
 - Embroidery thread(s) to match your design
 - Tape to hold fabric down in hoop (embroidery tape or transparent surgical tape works well. You will want a tape that tears easily & doesn't pull the stitches out)
 - Fabric & batting (page 1 of the PDF directions on the CD will give you the fabric sizes)
 - These designs can be done with many different pieces of fabric. Most of the pieces are small. Don't forget to check your fabric scraps for pieces for your project. 😊
 - Please choose your fabric according to the directions on the CD and the size of the design you have chosen to create.
 - Batting size will be based on the size of the design you choose.

****Please cut your fabric pieces prior to class. Since everyone may not be stitching the same design we will not have time to cut all of the fabric pieces in class.**

****Please have working knowledge of your machine as the educator will not have time to instruct on the use of your machine.**
