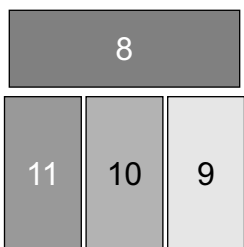

**Cut:**

- #1: (2) 3-7/8" squares, cut in half diagonally once
- #2: (1) 3-7/8" square, cut in half diagonally once
- #3: (1) 3-7/8" square, cut in half diagonally once
- #4: (1) 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangle
- #5: (1) 3-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangle
- #6: (2) 3-1/2" squares
- #7: (2) 3-1/2" squares
- #8: (1) 2-1/2" x 6-1/2" rectangle
- #9: (1) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle
- #10: (1) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle
- #11: (1) 2-1/2" x 4-1/2" rectangle

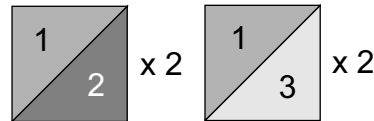
**Sew:** (Use Scant 1/4" Seams Throughout!)

1) Assemble block as shown:

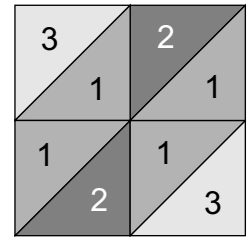

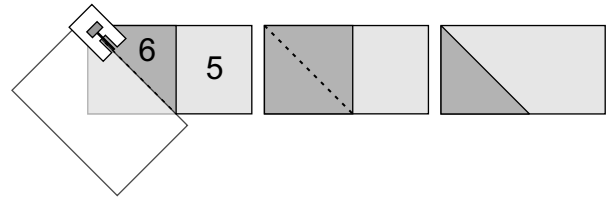
2) Make the following units:



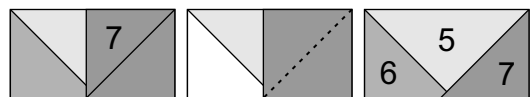
3) Assemble block:



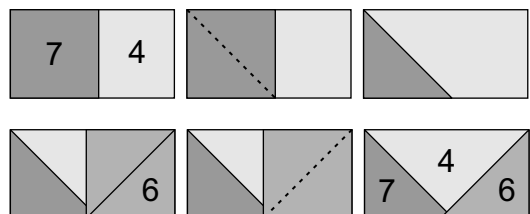
4) Place a #6 3-1/2" square right sides together (RST) on top of #5 rectangle as shown. Place a thin piece of cardstock or sandpaper diagonally as shown. Sew next to the edge of the cardstock. Alternatively, you may draw a diagonal pencil line on the fabric and sew on that. Flip back, press and trim underneath.



5) Place a #7 square RST on top of the unit as shown, sew, flip, press and trim as before.



6) Repeat, using #4, #6 and #7 fabrics in the positions shown.



7) Assemble block as shown at top of page.
