



**Class Name:** Beginning Needle Turn Appliqué, and Hand Quilting.

**Project:** Pineapple Hospitality Quilt or Monstera Leaf, wall hanging or pillow as desired.

**Instructor:** Elaine Bowles

**Preparation Class Activity:** Transfer pattern to clear plastic template; bring fabrics for either 4 square project or one block project. You will need scissors for cutting, basting thread, white and a needle of choice for basting, I prefer John James Millner either size 7 or 9. Bring note pad and pen for notes. A pattern will be provided by instructor. Read Hand Made Designs Handout.

**Supplies Required:** (please provide brand if possible)

- **Project Options**
- **Option 1:** Two 22 inch fabric squares: one for top design and other for background.
- **Option 2:** is made of multiple contrasting fabrics. Four square design means that the project is divided into four squares that are later joined. You would need four 11 inch top design fabrics, and for the background.
- Back fabric 28 inch square (or, to desired size of project), I use muslin if making a pillow.
- Wool batting 24 inch square. Or desired size of project.
- Thread: I use Mettler cotton with silk finish (Lavender spool). Matching top and back ground. if you can not find one to match perfectly, chose the darker color.
- Thread for basting, white cotton.
- Appliqué needles, I prefer John James Milliners size 7- 9.
- Betweens needles for hand quilting, I prefer size 7. But you may prefer and smaller needle (the bigger the number the smaller the needle).
- Fine pins with heat resistant when ironing.
- Scissors: Small with sharp point, and 'bandage or craft scissors to trimming.
- Fabric marker, make sure it will disappear after stitching.
- Wooden Hoop with screw mechanism: 16 - 18 inch and one inch thick.
- Thimble for hand quilting: Raised edge tumble for middle finger of needle hand.
- Notebook and pen for taking notes
- Kai Seam Ripper
- Remember to bring laughter and good stories for all.

**Optional but helpful supplies (if you want to iron and sew at your table which is fabulous):**

- Large wool pressing pad (17"x17" or more practical 17" x 24")

- Dritz mighty travel iron
- Needle Threader
