Supplies Required: (please provide brand if possible)

Book: More Twist and Turn Bargello Quilts

Option 1 Baby Quilt, approximate size 40x40

1/3 yard each of 10 Bargello fabrics

Option 2, throw approximate size 61x80

1/2 yard each of 20 Bargello fabrics

Sewing machine with a 1/4" foot and other accessories (cord, foot pedal, extension table)

Size 80/12 sewing needles

Aurfil thread

Rotary cutter with sharp blade

Medium cutting mat

Ruler. (The QUILTER SELECT rulers do no slip and is great for cutting strips)

Seam ripper (SEAM FIX seam ripper HIGHLY RECOMMENDED)

Magic fork pins or Clover straight pins

The purple thang, stiletto or awl. (THE PURPLE THANG HIGHLY RECOMMENDED)

Thread scissors

Scotch tape or glue stick

Couple of sheets of printer paper

Sharpie

ADDITIONAL NOTES

The key to the Bargello Quilt is the value of light to dark in your fabric selection. The example in the store is using a even gradation of one color tone from light to dark. If you use more than one color you will get a more striped effect. This is your quilt, do what is pleasing to your eye. Refer to page 25 and 26

I used an Ombre fabric in the baby quilt as one of my fabric choices. If using an Ombre you will need to length cut. 1 1/4 yards of fabric will give you enough for 3 of your colors in the baby quilt. 2 1/2 yards will give you enough fabric for 3 of your colors in the throw quilt.

I am willing to help you with fabric selection. I am at the store Tuesday, Wednesday and every other Sunday. Refer to pages 6 and 7 of the book.

CUT ALL STRIPS PRIOR TO CLASS. THE BABY QUILT REQUIRES 3 STRIPS 2 1/2" X 42" from each of the 10 color refer to page 13. **THE THROW REQUIRES 5 STRIPES 2 1/2" by 42"** from each of the 20 colors refer to page 20

Bring a piece of flannel or batting approximately 45" by 36"
