General Supply List

Sewing Machine in good working order

Scissors

Large 60 mm rotary cutter with sharp blade
(45mm works, 60 mm works better)

6 x 24 inch ruler – also handy to bring a 6 x 12 inch

Cutting mat

Iron

Pressing mat

Spray Starch

Neutral thread

Pins

Seam ripper

Helpful for organization – 20" x 30" foam board

Fabric Requirements:

To help in picking fabrics and understanding Buggy Barn method of construction, it would be helpful to read pages 2 and 3 in Crazy Favorite Things.

Bird Block fabric requirements – found on page 13, Crazy Favorite Things.

The bird template is approximately 14 ½" x 20 ½" and is dimensional so take care when purchasing directional fabrics.

One Fat quarter for each block, 10 fat quarters of contrasting fabrics for the bird blocks. Each block requires 4 fabrics, one for the bird body, one for the wing, one for the tail feathers and legs, and one for the background,

1/8 yard gold/yellow for the beaks, (1) ¼" – ¾" button per block for the birds eye.

Flower requirements on page 11 of book.

There's 10 flowers – 10 fat quarters of contrasting fabrics.

Flowers work in groups of three: one for the flower, one for the flower center and one for the background.

7" x 10" rectangles of 5 or 6 greens for stems and leaves

Class preparation and hints:

- * Have your fabric pressed and cut to fat quarters.
- * I will furnish the traced patterns for the flower and bird – (as suggested in # 2 on pages 11 and 14, one less thing for you to figure out.
- * Great idea to read the directions for stacking, cutting and sewing the flower and bird blocks , page 11 – 15, particularly if this is your first experience with the Buggy Barn method.
- * May be a good idea to bring extra fat quarters just in case...
