FABRIC For Large cover

Design size is 11x 7.5

Bernina 7&8 Series machines Must have Jumbo or Maxi hoop to make Lg notebook cover

- 1 piece cork – 11 1/2" x 8" for outside cover
- 2 pieces cork – 3 1/2" x 8" for inside flaps
- 1 piece fabric – 11 1/2" x 8" for inside lining*
- 1 piece fabric – 5.5" x 7.5" for reverse applique*

*can be the same

Bernina 5 Series machines MUST have Mega* hoop**

You will be able to make the small notebook cover Design size 8.5 x 6.75

- 1 piece cork – 9 1/2" x 6.75" for outside cover
- 2 pieces cork – 3" x 6.75" for inside flaps
- 1 piece fabric – 9 1/2" x 6.75" for inside lining*
- 1 piece fabric – 4.5" x 6.25" for reverse applique*

*can be the same
