

**Class Name:** Crazy Woolly Birds

**Instructor:** DuAnn Wright

**Supplies Needed:**

**Felted Wool** – If using recycled wool/machine wash in hot water, rinse in cold water, and dry completely in dryer.

**Background Wool** – Cut felted wool 14½" X 24½" - after all the stitching is complete, we will trim to 14" X 24"

Backing fabric (I used cotton) - cut one rectangle 15" X 25" – this allows for a seam allowance to be turned back when finishing edge. I also use small strips of fusible web to press seam allowance before sewing edge by hand.

**Branch** –Cut bias strip from felted wool that is ½" X 52". Crosscut into one bias strip ½" X 22" and 5 strips ½" X 6".

**Please have the background wool fabric and branch fabric cut before class.**

You will also need 1 box (200 wool Pennies) in 1" and 1 ½" in Diameter circles (you will have leftovers for other fun projects) OR

you could cut your own circles out of scrap wool pieces. PURCHASING the box of circles makes it so much easier and the circles are uniform in size.

#24 Chenille Needle – for Embroidery stitches using #8 perle cotton

#18 Chenille needle – for heavier threads that are too large for #24

Straw Needle #10 or other beading needle for sewing on beads (Optional)

**Perle Cotton** in Size 8 or 12 in variety of colors or variegated colors –will be used for embroidery stitches and couching on threads, yarn, and rick rack

**Beads**- small seed beads or other beads of your choice/also beading needle and thread

**Baby rick rack** - used for some of the bird legs

**Threads and yarns** in a variety of sizes and textures (The Quilt Crossing will have available for purchase a variety pack of 10 threads in 1 yard lengths) PLEASE PURCHASE BEFORE THE DAY OF THE CLASS so we can start on time!

**Basic sewing supplies**- small ruler, scissors, pins, (glue stick or appliqués glue optional) Bring whatever you need to help in the placement of the pattern and to transport home.

**Optional** – Book on Embroidery Stitches
