

Class Name: Dancing Squares Wall Quilt

Supplies Needed: Book Purchase Required: *A New Spin on Curved Piecing*

Each of the nine blocks in this quilt will consist of four pieced Corner Blocks, each made from the same pattern. Color choices can be a light and a medium for the blocks and a dark for the Dancing square (ribbon); or darks and lights for the blocks and a bright for the Dancing square. This would make a beautiful baby quilt using pastels and an accent color.

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS:

The background color of each corner block can be cut from an 8" square, so if you're going for a scrappy look, consider purchasing a Layer Cake or other collections of 10" squares. A strip needs to be at least 8" wide; or ¼ yard if purchasing fabric off bolts.

Lights for Blocks.....a total of 1 ½ yards
Mediums for Blocks.....a total of 1 ½ yards
Accent Fabric for Dancing Squares.....1/2 yard
Optional self-made piping.....1/3 yard
Backing.....1 ½ yards
Binding.....1/2 yard

Warning: Certain fabrics which have been brought to class have had a bad reaction to having freezer paper ironed onto them; most recently, a batik from Moda. You may want to test your fabrics by setting your iron at a high (Cotton or Linen) setting and pressing a scrap of Freezer Paper onto the right side of the fabric. If the Freezer Paper doesn't peel off easily, you may want to save that fabric for another project. The Moda fabric I mentioned WOULD NOT let go of the Freezer Paper, and the section it was ironed onto was ruined.

SUPPLIES: I will provide freezer paper sheets with the pattern already printed on them to students in class.

Freezer Paper sheets in 8 ½" x 11" format	Fine-point Sharpie in Black
Roxanne's Basting Glue	Wash-out fabric markers
Paper and Fabric Scissors	Small, inexpensive paint brush

Optional but helpful supplies:

While irons and boards are supplied in the classroom, it can be helpful to bring your own tabletop models.
