

**Class Name:** Dresden Star Quilt

**Instructor:** Karen Hodge

**Supplies Needed:**

- Multiple batik fabrics for the dresden stars – fat quarters and 1/3 yd cuts work well. Since the plate/star pieces range in size from 12” to 7”, you can plan accordingly. I used various pieces from my stash.
- Background fabric – the amount will depend on the size of the quilt top desired. I used 1 ½ yards.
- Marti Michelle “Perfect Patchwork Templates – Dresden Plate Set” for making 7”, 10 ½”, and 12” plates.
- Neutral thread for piecing; monofilament or matching thread for applique
- Best Press spray starch
- Freezer paper for making center circles
- Roxanne’s Glue Baste or a temporary basting glue of your choice, but not a glue stick.
- Microtex sewing machine needles – size 80/12 for batik fabric
- Sewing machine
- Rotary cutter and ruler

**Optional but helpful supplies:**

- Large and medium Clover yo-yo makers (optional)
- Circle making templates or rulers for circles up to 6” diameter. My circles range from 2” to 6” and I used a variety of items to draw the circles.
