

Class Name: Easy Applique

Supplies Needed:

This class will teach you the different techniques of invisible appliqué using freezer paper along with a glue stick or starch. You will work on a floral design using fabrics and thread provided in your purchased kit. The floral appliqué pattern is provided in the class handout and will provide you with the technique of machine appliqué using freezer paper and clear thread

Sewing Machine with zigzag stitch

Open toe embroidery foot (if available-easier to see stitching)-#20 Bernina foot

Size 70 or 80 Schmetz machine needle

General Sewing Supplies

Olfa Rotary cutter/Olfa mat/Creative Grid ruler to be used to cut stems

Fabric and Paper Scissors

Small stiff paint brush or Q-tip – will be used to apply starch to seam allowance

Wooden skewer or toothpick for ease in turning in seam allowance

Spray starch (I will have some for you to use if you don't have any)

Glue Stick

Freezer paper (approximately 12" X 18")

100% cotton thread in neutral color

Invisible nylon or polyester thread

KIT will be available for purchase at The Quilt Crossing

OR bring the following fabrics to class:

16" square of background fabric – can be muslin or fabric of your choice

1 fat quarter of green fabric for leaves and stems – cut fat quarter in half **DIAGONALLY** and cut one strip $\frac{3}{4}$ " wide from the bias edge using your rotary cutter and mat – bring all of the green fabric to class. In addition you will need small scraps (5" Squares) of 3 different colors for flowers, 7" square of medium value fabric for vase, and small scraps of yellow/gold for flower centers.

If you have an appliqué pattern that you want to make at a later date – please bring it to class if you have any questions – the larger more simple appliqué shapes work best for this method.

Optional but helpful supplies:
