



**Class Name:** Edge to Edge Quilting with Embroidery 101

**Instructor:** Colleen Anderson

We will spend time making and learning how to use the template which you will be able to use on multiple quilts so worth making a good one. Take a moment to review the information in the book so you have an idea what we will be learning. We are all going to use the same design in class and I will be prepared to copy that design onto your machine but **BRING THE BOOK AND CD** to class.

### **Supplies Required:**

1. *Edge-To-Edge Quilting on Your Embroidery Machine Book with CD by Amelie Scott Designs*
2. *Quilt Crossing has created a kit for your convenience. The kit will have the fabric and batting and the template material. So easy for you! **Come to class with the quilt sandwich spray basted.***

Come to class with the following:

- Your machine and embroidery module.
- Your Jumbo or Maxi Hoop (**SMALLER HOOPS WILL NOT WORK**)
- Your hoop template with the gray clips attached.
- A pen or pencil for marking the fabric template
- A hand needle for burying threads
- Your all purpose sewing foot for sewing the securing stitch around the template
- Your embroidery foot.
- Thread you want to quilt with - I use Isacord most of the time. Top and bobbin. I used Isacord Color 150 on the model.
- At least 4 pins to pin the template to the quilt.
- Scissors and snips

### **Optional but helpful supplies:**

A MASTERHOOPER/HOOP HELPER is a very helpful tool when hooping a quilt sandwich. Bring one if you have it.

We appreciate it when you buy your class supplies from us - these purchases enable us to offer a robust class schedule and keep your dollars local.
