

Class Name: Harlequin Supply List

Supplies Needed:

Harlequin by Aardvark Quilt pattern

Fabrics and supplies are listed to complete a 40 1/2" by 56" quilt, if you are making a larger Quilt, more fabrics will be needed to complete the quilt.

PLEASE NOTE THAT YOU NEED THE FULL WIDTH AND LENGTH OF THE FABRIC STRIPS, TO CUT OUT THE DIAMOND SHAPES, THIS IS NOT A PATTERN THAT ADAPTS WELL TO PRE-CUTS.

6 – 1/3yd cuts large floral or large motif prints for the large diamonds

6 – 1/4yd cuts medium to small prints for the medium diamonds

6 – 1/8yd cuts dark value fabric for the 4-patch diamonds

1/2 yd fabric for the binding

1 3/4 yd 44/45" wide fabric for the back

We will be working with paper templates, so I recommend taking the suggested number of copies of the templates pages and carefully cut out the templates on the outside line from the copies, to make your pattern complete.

In addition to the supplies above, you will need the following:
Sewing machine, in good working order with manual if needed
Pins

Sharp rotary cutter, scissors (both paper and fabric)

Rulers – 6 1/2" x 24 1/2", and 9" or 12" square ruler

Cutting mat, small iron and pressing surface to have on table beside you.

Come to class prepared to have fun and walk out with several blocks completed of each diamond. You can finish the rest at home, at your leisure. I work at The Quilt Crossing on Wednesday or you can contact me at 208-939-5664 or donnaquilts5924@gmail.com
