Supplies Required:

- Sewing machine with ¼" foot and other accessories (cord, foot pedal, extension table, and knee lift)
- Size 70/10 Microtex Sharp sewing needles
- Pattern including the instructions and foundation papers
- Fabric, requirements for 1 project are noted on the back of the pattern
- Thread to blend with your fabrics along with pre-wound bobbins (one neutral thread is fine)
- Iron and pressing mat if you want to press at your sewing station
- Rotary cutters with new blades (it is helpful to have 3 sizes available)
 - 60 mm for cutting fabric
 - 45 mm for cutting templates
 - 28 mm for trimming
- Medium sized cutting mat if you want to do your trimming at your sewing station
- A piece of template plastic (3"x12" works well)
- Ruler for cutting fabric and templates (24"x 6" or 6 1/2" works well)
- 12" Add-A-Quarter ruler
- Craft glue stick
- Purple Thang
- Thread scissors
- Seam ripper

Pre-Class Instructions:

Please read the instructions completely through at least one time before class. This will help to ensure you understand the cutting information noted below. It is strongly encouraged that you have the papers, and fabrics for the entire project cut out and ready to use in class.

Fabric Selection: Fabric requirements for the project shown on the cover are noted on the back of the pattern. There is a lot of flexibility in choosing your fabrics. For my model, I used 8 fat quarters (4 coral print and 4 green print) for the hearts and frames. In this case there are two hearts with the same color scheme. I used a single color for the background of the hearts. You could use a layer cake and select 16 10" squares, one for each heart. If taking this approach, I suggest using one or two fabrics for the frames and one for the heart background. Have fun picking out your border fabric. There are lots of options!

Foundation Papers: If you are making the project shown on the pattern cover, cut out foundation papers for 16 blocks. The pattern includes papers for 64 blocks. Note that there is Block 1 and Block 2. The only difference is in the angle the heart sits. You probably want to use half Block 1 and half Block 2, so cut 8 blocks of each. Place these papers into a baggie as not to mis-place them.

Fabric Cutting Instructions: The cutting instructions for the blocks is noted on the inside of the pattern. For the heart fabrics and frame pieces, I cut strips, stacked them, and then cut the required number of pieces. Cut the required background pieces.
