



QUILT in a BOWL - ART BOWL

CLASS DESCRIPTION

Create a three dimensional art piece in the shape of a bowl. Starting with heavy duck canvas, you will shape a bowl and then decorate with your own design and embellishments. Size of finished bowl is approximately 17" diameter.

TOOL / SUPPLY LIST:

Sewing machine able to Satin stitch or Zigzag
Needles size 80/12 or 90/14, SHARP and METALLIC
Open embroidery foot or Zigzag foot, free motion embroidery foot (optional)
Extra bobbins
Fabric scissors, paper scissors, seam ripper
Rotary cutter and cutting mat
Pencil, note pad, ruler
½ yard of fabric for outside of bowl (batik preferred but not required)
Lots of fabric scraps
Decorative threads – cotton, rayon, polyester
Small iron or fusing iron and personal ironing pad (optional)
Teflon sheet or 1 yard of parchment paper to protect the ironing board

Heavy duck canvas – 18 to 20 oz. weight (1/2 yard)

Wonder Under (light weight – Pellon 805) – 4 yards
