CLASS DESCRIPTION

Learn the art of piecing free form curves without pinning, marking or clipping. Add interest by incorporating multi-directional and 3 dimensional elements. Create your own lace and learn to insert it into your quilt. Embellish your work with yarns and threads of different weights. Finish off your piece using a clean and elegant facing technique. You will piece, quilt, embellish and face your quilt in class. Size of finished work is approximately 20" x 30".

LEVEL OF EXPERIENCE: Advanced Beginner (simple piecing and basic quilting experience)

SUPPLY LIST

- **Tool/Supply List**
 - Rotary cutter, mat and quilter's ruler
 - Sewing machine and accessories for straight sewing
 - Seam ripper, pins and scissors
 - Hand sewing needle
 - Free motion and/or walking foot.
- **Fabrics**
 - Approximately 15 different cotton fabrics of one color way (I used yellow for one piece, blue for the other) varying from light to medium to dark (solid color, marbled, batiks, small to medium prints). Only a small amount of each, ¼ yard or less of each. Fat quarters are perfect!
 - A very small amount of one or two accent colors, (I used orange/yellow in the blue piece and blue in the yellow piece)). Can be a print or solid color fabric.
 - 30" x 30" piece of batting
 - 1 yard fabric for backing
- **Threads**
 - Neutral thread for piecing
 - Your choice of colored or invisible threads for quilting
 - A few pieces (each no longer than 36") of yarn to embellish your work
- **\$3 lab fee**
- Sewing Machine
