Supplies Needed:

The book “All My Thanks and Love to Quilts” by Keiko Goke

Fabrics – up to 18, a minimum of 9 – primarily solids or tone-on-tones. Pieces need to measure at least 9” x 9”

Fusible Web – I really like Soft Fuse (very light so the finished piece isn’t stiff) and it comes in a package of ten 8” x 9” pieces that are just the right size. If you use a different brand, you’ll need about 1-1/4 yards.

General Supplies: pencil, at least 9 sheets of regular paper, paper scissors and fabric scissors, straight pins, rotary cutter, mat, ruler, and any other basic sewing supplies you normally use.

For the second class, you will need:

Sewing machine (and normal accessories for it)

Threads-both threads that blend and decorative threads that contrast

Open-toe foot for your machine (Bernina #20, for example)

Walking foot

Safety pins or 505 adhesive spray

Marker such as SewLine mechanical pencil or Clover Chacoliner

Craft-size batt (36” x 46”)

7/8 yard of backing fabric – a busy print is better
