



**Class Name:** Machine Binding

**Instructor:** Sandy Lieske

**Pre-Class Prep:** Cut your binding strips for both projects as noted above. Black or white strips will work or ask to look at the fabric kit to see what other color you might prefer for your bindings.

Sew both sets of strips together end to end. I prefer sewing them at a 45 degree angle. I do this by trimming both ends of each strip at that angle using my cutting mat as a guide. Press the seams open.

**Supplies Required:**

- Sewing machine with a #37, #71, and #1 or #20 foot and other accessories (cord, foot pedal, extension table, and knee lift) (The feet numbers reference Bernina feet, your machine feet will be different if other than a Bernina)
- Table Runner Machine Binding Class Supply Kit
- Binding strips for both projects including (4) 2" strips and (4) 2.5" strips
- Aurifil thread to blend with your binding strips plus bobbins wound in the same colors
- Schmetz or Bernina Size 80/12 sewing needles
- 60 mm rotary cutter Olfa, Quilter's Select, or Martelli are all fine
- Quilter's Select or Creative Grid ruler for cutting fabric if you haven't already cut your strips ahead of time
- Clover .55mm Flower Head or .5mm 1 7/8" Glass head pins (long shanks)
- Clover binder clips
- Sewline or Quilter's Select glue pen
- Thread scissors (Havel's or Kai work well)
- Kai Seam ripper

**Optional but helpful supplies:**

- Large wool pressing pad (17"x17" or more practical 17" x 24")
- Dritz mighty travel iron
- 24" x 36" sized cutting mat to do your trimming at your sewing station

**Sewing Machine Needed for Class?** Yes, or you can rent one for \$5, just let us know prior to class.

We appreciate it when you buy your class supplies from us - these purchases enable us to offer a robust class schedule and keep your dollars local.

**Cancellation Policy:** We must commit to our teachers and to other students one week before the class begins so we can't give refunds or transfers after that time (unless we can fill your spot from the waiting list).
