

**Class Name:** Machine Quilting

**Supplies Needed:**

Sewing Machine in good working order, cleaned and oiled

Sewing machine and manual – please know how to drop or cover the feed dogs

Straight stitch throat plate if available (Single-hole)

#10 {70} or #12 {80} sewing machine needle

Bobbin filled with natural or off-white thread – size #50 wt. or machine embroidery thread, cotton or cotton/polyester. (I use Mettler 50 wt. or Mettler Fine Embroidery 100% Cotton Art. 248, Ne 60/2 (100)

Walking Foot, if available or a straight or zigzag foot (used for straight quilting lines)

Darning or Free Motion Machine Embroidery foot – This is Essential (must be purchased before class)  
Make sure that your machine has the ability to do free machine embroidery and that you have all the necessary equipment. If your machine is not capable of the technique you will not be able to do half of the exercises.

Generals marking pencil, silver pencil, or quilt marking tool of your choice

Seam ripper

Scissors for snipping threads

You NEED to purchase the machine quilting kit from The Quilt Crossing before the class.

**Optional but helpful supplies:**

Masking tape

Quilting gloves
