

Class Name: My First Skirt

Instructor: Teri Brown

Welcome to the world of sewing. In this class you will learn to sew a lined skirt. All the supplies you need may be purchased here at the Quilt Crossing.

Supplies Needed:

Fabric; Two yards of cotton for the skirt outside
Two yards of cotton for the lining
If you want a contrast fabric for the yoke,
ADD 1/2 yard of cotton(you still need 2 yards for outside skirt)

Fina Skirt Pattern

¼ yard light-weight fusible interfacing - I like Ultra-Weft

12" zipper

Thread to match your fabric. I like Mettler 50 weight cotton

Quilt & sew ruler (2"x 18")

Tape measure

Seam ripper

Bent-handled dressmaker shears (7" or 8" blade)

Straight pins. I like Clover Silk Pins with red and white heads

Sewing machine in good working order with the manual and bobbins

Regular presser foot and zipper foot for your machine

Hand sewing needle

Soft lead pencil or fabric marker/chalk

Paper and pencil for taking notes

Optional but helpful supplies:

Six inch ruler with seam guide

Small sharp pair of scissors to trim seams
