



**Class Name:** Deck the Boughs Tea Towels      **Instructor:** Laura Croft

**Pre-Class Prep:** Towel fabric is approximately 16" wide. To make all three towels, cut three pieces of toweling, each approximately 27" long (3/4 yard); turn under 1/2" on both ends of each towel and press; turn under 1/2" again on both ends of each towel and press; top stitch both ends of each towel in place to create the hems.

**Supplies Needed:**

- 'Stitches from the Yuletide' book by Kathy Schmitz
- 27" (3/4 yard) of 16" tan Moda toweling with red stripes for each towel (total for three towels = 2.25 yards)
- Your choice of embroidery floss – suggested: brown, red, dark green, dark gray-blue
- Embroidery needle
- Embroidery hoop
- White Pen-Touch quick dry/permanent pen
- Press pad and iron
- Small scissors for snipping
- Notebook and pen for taking notes

**NOTE:** Glad Press'n Seal plastic wrap will be supplied by the instructor
