



Class Name: One Block Wonder Panel Quilt

Supplies Needed:

- Sewing machine with a $\frac{1}{4}$ " foot and other accessories (cord, foot pedal, extension table, and knee lift)
- Size 80/12 sewing needles
- One-Block Wonder Panel Quilts book by Maxine Rosenthal and Nancy Miller
- Fabric Panels. 6 are needed to make the kaleidoscope blocks and an optional 7th is needed if you plan to layout your quilt around the panel similar to the hummingbird model
- Aurifil thread to blend with your panels
- Rotary cutter
- Medium sized cutting mat if you want to do your trimming at your sewing station
- Quilter's Select or Creative Grid ruler for cutting fabric strips (24 x 6 or 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " works best)
- 60 degree ruler for cutting triangles from strips
- .55mm Flower Head or .5mm 1 $\frac{7}{8}$ " Glass head pins (long shanks)
- Thread scissors (Havel's or Kai work well)
- Seam ripper
- For the second session you will need a large piece of flannel or a sheet if you would like to pin your design to that to take home.
