Supplies Needed: Book Purchase Required: *One Block Wonder*

FABRIC REQUIREMENTS:

Look for a large-scale print with lots of movement. One suggestion was to look for images about the size of your fist in your fabric. A more-limited color palette may be easier to work with, so avoid prints with more than 4 or 5 major colors.

You need 6 repeats of your fabric's pattern. Fabric repeats vary from about 8" to 24". You will want a repeat of at least 12". To determine this, open out your fabric and measure along one selvage. Find an obvious point in an image to begin, and measure to the same point along the selvage. (A fabric store employee should be able to help you do this,) If your repeat is 12", you will need to purchase at least 2 yards of fabric. If your repeat is 24", purchase at least 4 yards. Whatever the repeat, multiply inches by 6, divide by 36, add a couple of inches, and purchase THAT quantity of fabric.

The final size of your project will vary,

SUPPLIES:

60 degree triangle ruler

Rotary cutter, cutting matt, and ruler at least 24" long

Flower pins

Sewing machine and all basic sewing supplies

Optional but helpful supplies:

Portable Design Wall
