



Class Name: Prepping Your Quilt for Free Motion Quilting

Supplies Required: (please provide brand if possible)

- Quilt top, batting, and backing that you want to baste.
 - If you are not sure of the yardage for the back or batting, Karen can help you figure it out!
- Curved safety pins – Honestly, 1 ½” pins are the easiest to use (Collins Quilt Safe Curved Basting Pins Fine Wire #2) but if you have the 1” pins and want to use those that is fine, too. I’ve also used flower head pins but just be prepared to experience many pin pricks!
- Clamps or painter’s tape for securing the backing and batting to the table. I use 1” Mini Spring Clamps made by Bora Portamate and are available on Amazon (20 pcs per box). Or, you can use 1” metal file clamps.

Important Note: We cannot spray baste in the classroom because of fumes and over-spraying damage to the floor!

Optional but helpful supplies:
