Materials List (bring a pencil to class):

- Top fabric: 1 rectangle 16" x 20"
- Backing: 1 rectangle 18" x 22"
- Batting: 1 rectangle 18" x 22"
- 4-8 practice quilt sandwiches 10" x 10" in a solid or blender fabric so you can see what you are doing!
- BERNINA #72 adjustable ruler foot
- A straight line quilting ruler, Every Curves ruler set, every circle ruler set (you'll need a straight line quilting ruler and some circle rulers bring the rulers you already own).
- Machine quilting gloves or anything you like to use for machine quilting
- Supreme Slider
- marking tool of choice (chalk-o line, wash-away pen, sew-line marking pencil)
- cutting ruler that is at least 12" in one direction
- Aurifil 50 wt. thread---choose what color you would like
- 90/14 or 80/12 topstitch or quilting needle
- brass safety pins
