

Class Name: Quilt As You Go

Supplies Needed:

Easy Diamonds Quilt Pattern, by Praire Sky Quilting. One sheet of template plastic, Good cotton thread to so ordinate with your fabrics, sewing machine in good working order.

General sewing supplies, pins, rulers and marking pens that will show on your fabrics. Scissors, a rotary cutter with a sharp blade. We have several cutting mats and ironing stations in our classroom.

Good cotton fabrics for the top, cotton batting (I used Dream Cotton, Request) and backing fabrics. PLEASE NOTE THAT THE BATTING AND BACKING WILL BE USED IN THIS WORKSHOP, so please bring the fabric pressed and ready to cut. I hope you will get several blocks done in class, so can begin to assemble the blocks and learn to do the tope stitching.

This workshop will be fun and informative. The emphasis will be on accurate cutting and sewing. You will enjoy this quilt as you go process, and be able to use it on other quilts in the future.

Optional but helpful supplies:

Zipper foot (#4), to sew the blocks and rows together, and an edge foot #10, for top stitiching the sashing. My sewing machine is a Bernina 430. Bring what you use on your machine for this process.
