

Class Name: Quilt as you Go Bargello

Supplies Needed:

PLEASE NOTE THAT WE NEED THE BACKING AND BATTING THE FIRST CLASS

Fabrics:

½ yard @ of five colors of good quality fabrics

1 ¼ yards of backing fabric

40 x 42 rectangle of of good cotton batting (I use Dream Cotton, Request or Select)

½ yd for binding

Please bring your sewing machine in good working order. The bobbin should be filled with a good quality thread that coordinates with your backing fabric. An accurate quarter inch seam is very important, using a quarter inch foot or walking foot are ideal, but your regular foot will work also, please have the ¼" marked on your machine.

We do offer several ironing boards and cutting mats in the classroom, but please bring your own if you want them by your side.

General sewing/quilting supplies, pins, scissors, rotary cutter, 6 or 6 ½" by 24 inch ruler. Markers that will show on the batting, but not disappear with ironing. I use the water soluble blue type.

You will need paper and pen for taking notes and marking rows, small colored sticky dots or squares come in handy too.

I will be happy to help you pick out fabrics for this class, I work at the store on Wednesday's.

Optional but helpful supplies:

Walking foot, or quarter inch foot to fit your sewing machine.
