Amanda Murphy—Design and then Quilt 2-day class



Learn how Amanda plans her quilting designs so that they both enhance the piecing and enable a square and smooth finish. Quilting affords the opportunity to add another layer of design and you don't have to be an expert to get spectacular results!

We work with pen and paper in the first half of class, designing on top of piecing handouts that Amanda provides. During the second half of the class we practice the rulerwork or free-motion that helps us achieve great results!

- Collins Quilt and Sew Ruler (Straight line ruler)
- Scratch Paper
- #72 ruler foot (if you own a Bernina) or equivalent Westalee Ruler foot for your machine
- 90/14 topstitch needle and Aurifil 50 wt. thread
- Stitch regulator with open toe foot option or other free-motion foot
- 15 quilt sandwiches (10" x 10" squares are great put a blender (grunge or tone-on-tone fabric on at least one side, you want to be able to see your work)
- snips
- quilting gloves, marking tools like choco-liners and wash away pens.
- Supreme Slider or Free-Motion Glider
- The Rulerwork Quilting Idea Book and the Free-Motion Quilting Idea (These are both books from Amanda which are optional but will no doubt be helpful to have.
- Marking tools things like wash-away pens and chalk-o-liners
- Brass safety pins
- · Superior Kimono silk
